Since 2009, the Kyushu University has organized the program with our partner universities in ASEAN countries, in cooperation with the ASEAN Secretariat and the ASEAN University Network (AUN).

Since Covid-19 is still far from being under control in many countries, AsTW 2022 will be held **ONLINE** from March 7 to 18, 2022. We welcome applicants from ASEAN countries and the rest of the world. The medium of instruction is English. The Kyushu University provides scholarships for the selected participants mainly from ASEAN countries.
